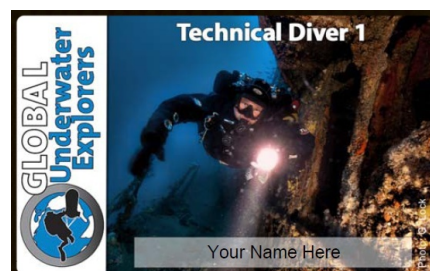

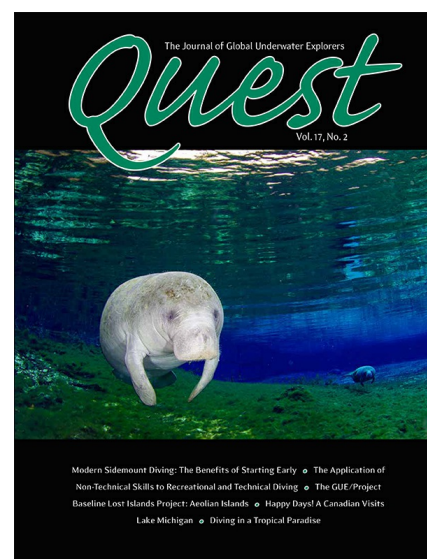
Brand new issue of *Quest* Magazine out now!
