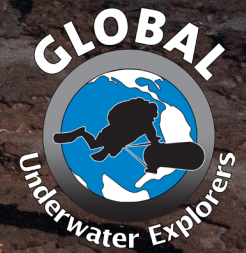

Despite seemingly growing levels of global uncertainty, the world seems intent to move forward, brave the challenges, and best of all, go diving. By the end of 2021, GUE had recovered to pre-pandemic activity levels, but growth remained modest. By 2023, we had returned to pre-pandemic growth levels with a steady 12% growth cycle. The year also saw great progress in the development of Level 3 programs, including a Tech 3 program on *Britannic*, the site of GUE's first international wreck project that occurred in 1999. 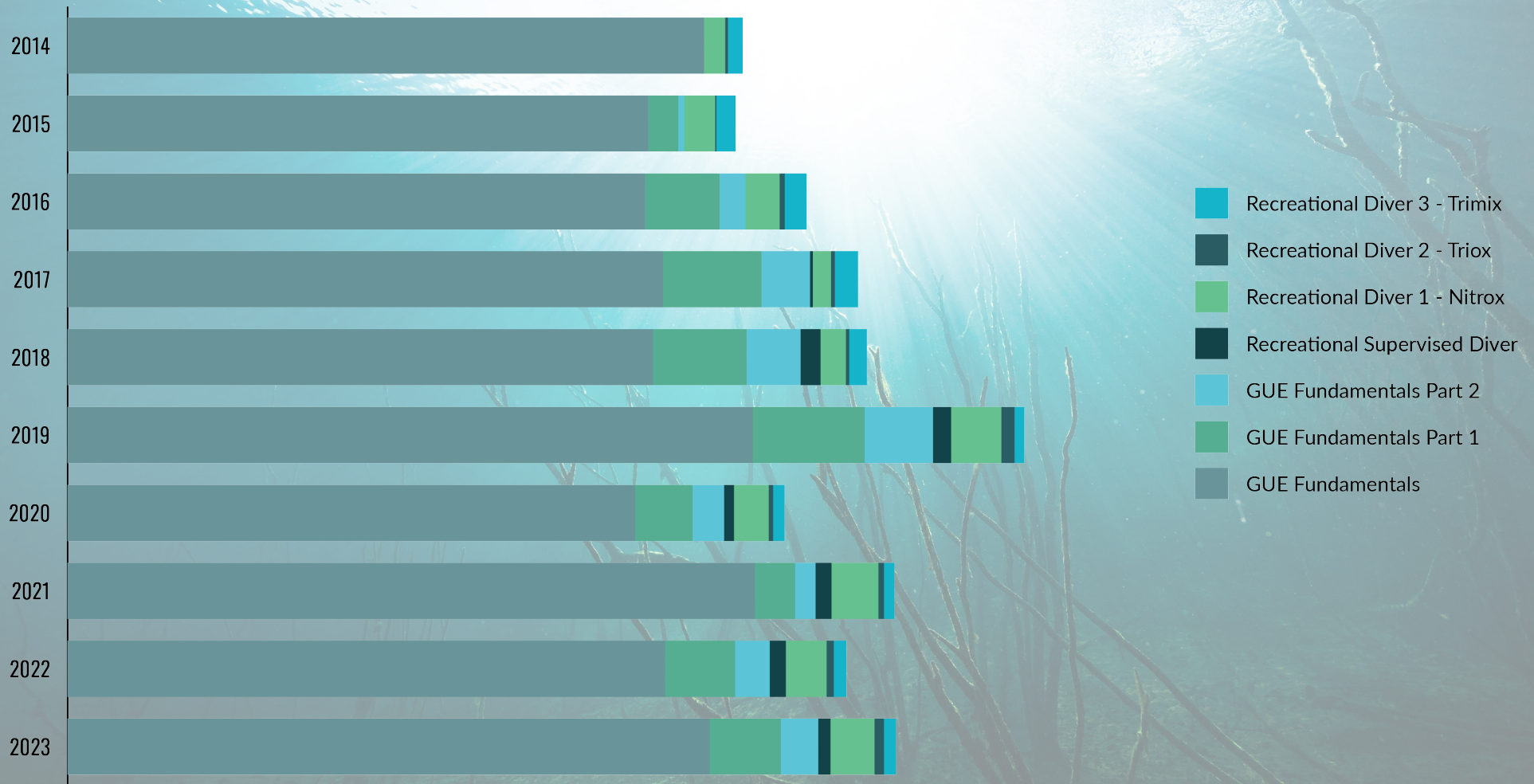

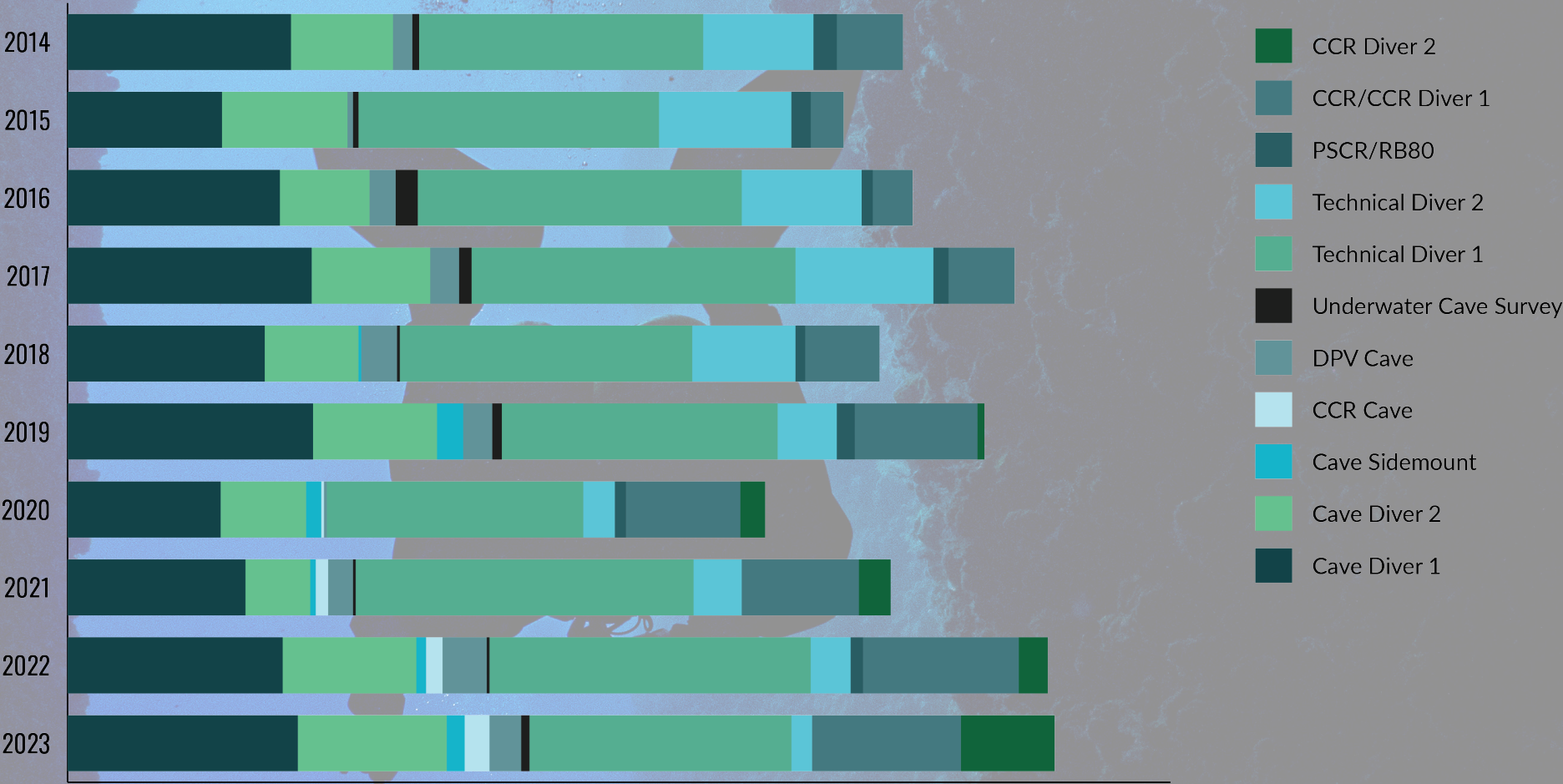

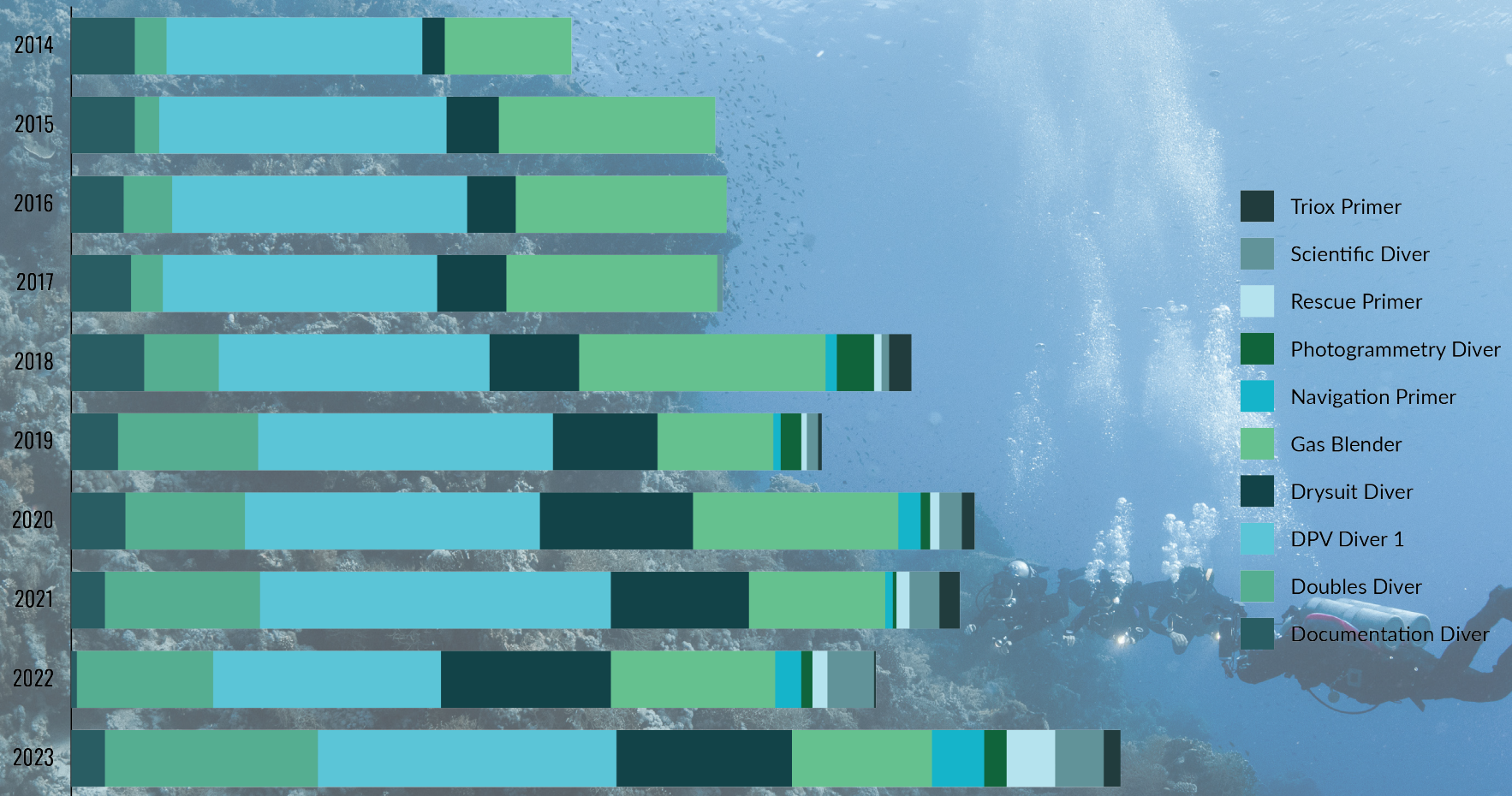

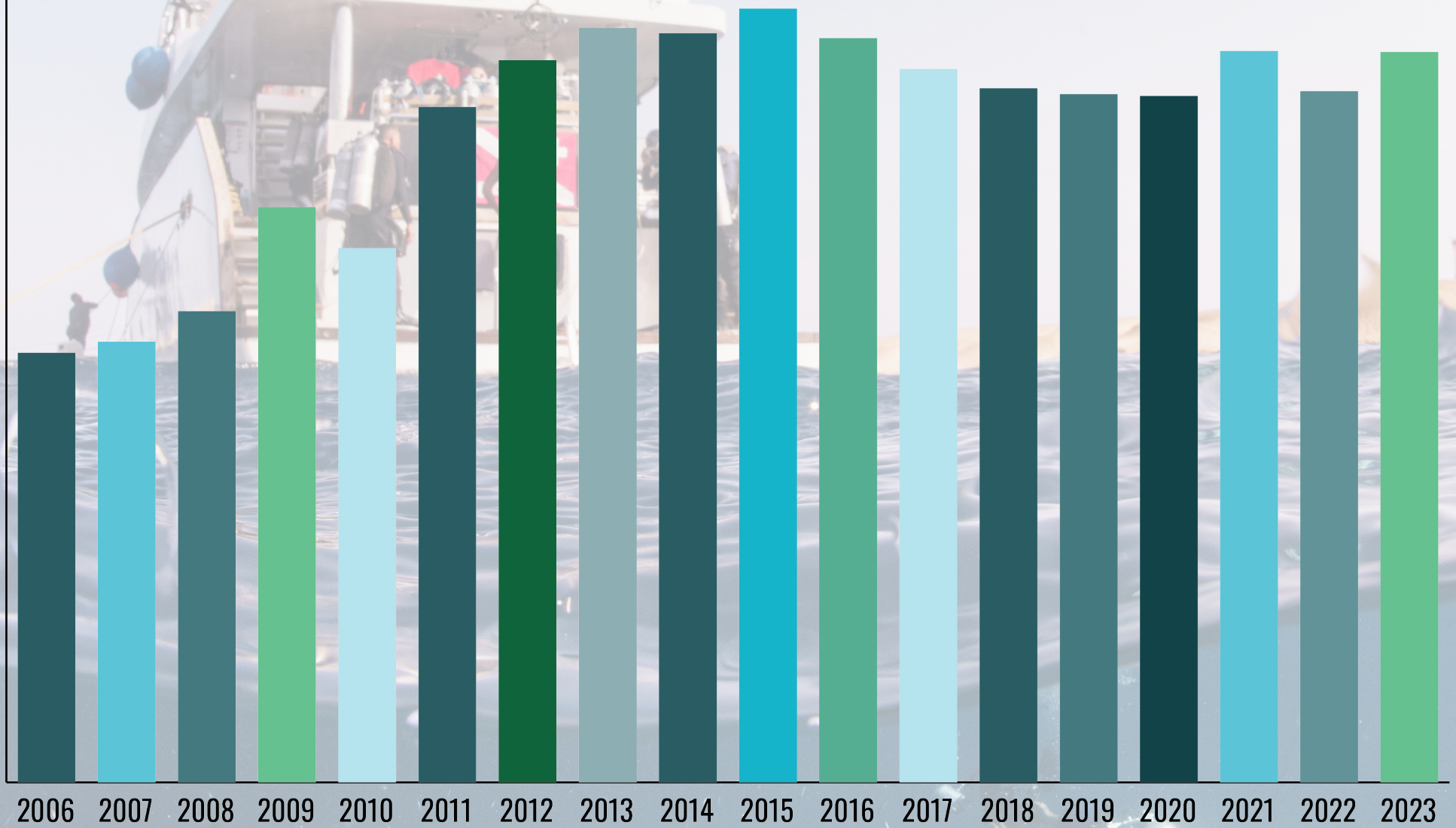

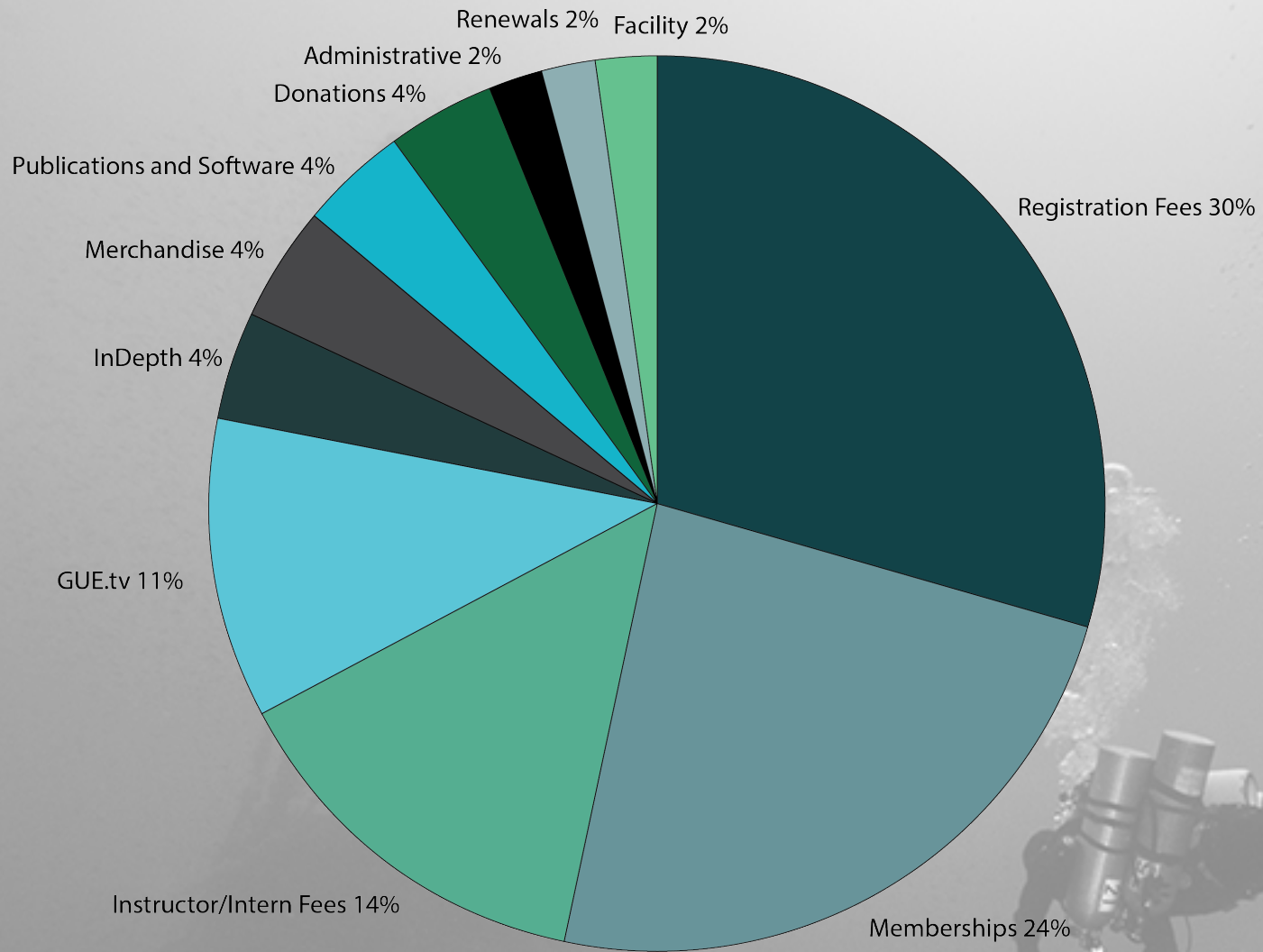

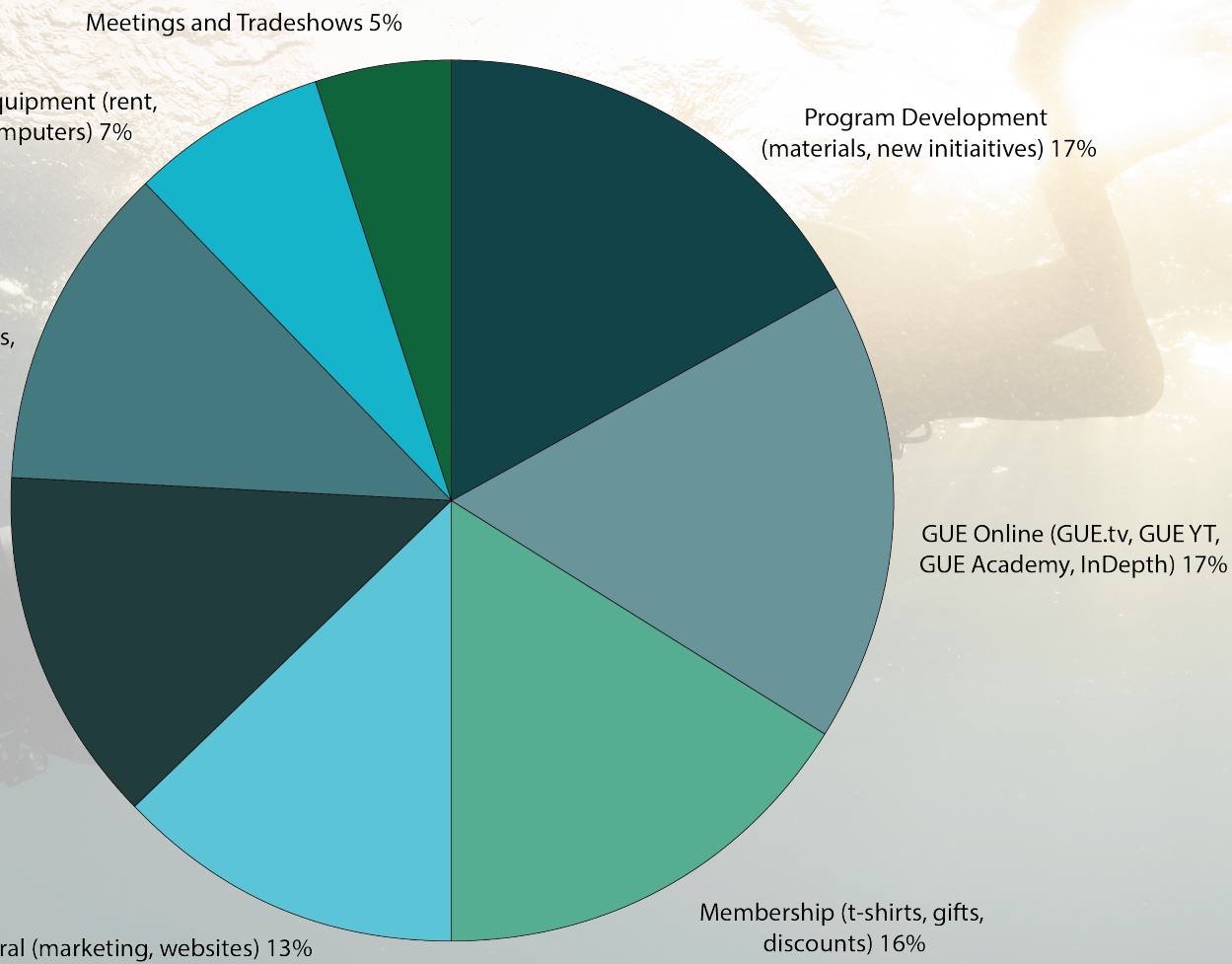
