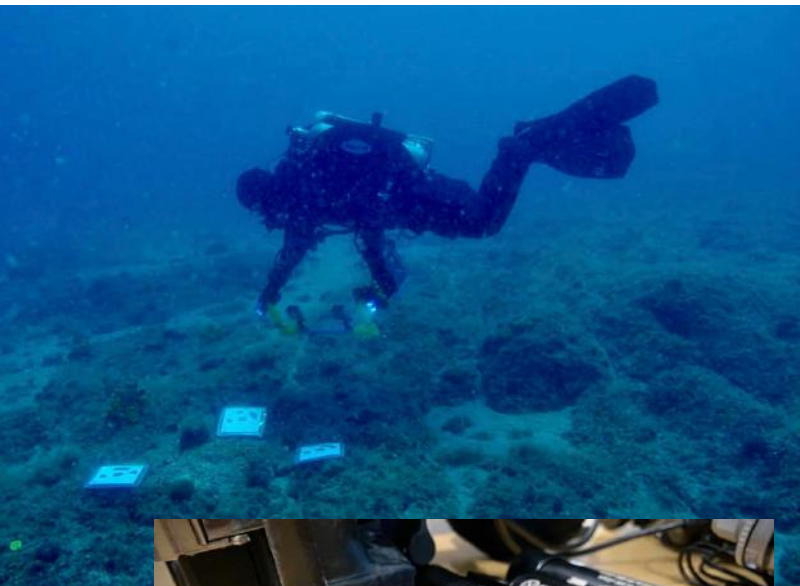


GUE Rec/Science Week

- Deployed sensors and hydrophones to monitor environmental changes

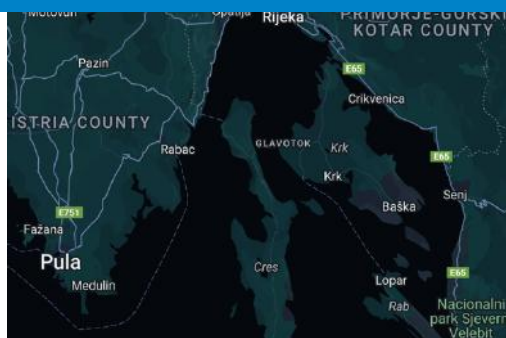
These efforts are crucial for the protection of these shallow water habitats and hopefully the data we collected will play a vital role in ensuring the preservation of these beautiful marine environments.
